
Turning on Security in Windows 10

1. Press Wins key + I

(Settings will open.)



2. Click on the **Update & Security** icon.

(Locate Windows Security category)



click items on right



3. Click **Windows Security** category.

(If you scroll down the page you will find links to learn more about keeping your PC safe.)



4. At the top of the page, click the Open Windows Security button.



If everything has a green circle with a check mark you are good.



- 5. If not click **Virus & threat protection** category on the left.
- 6. Click Manage settings link on the right.

7. Turn on **Real-time protection** and **Cloud-delivered protection**.

- 8. Click the **back arrow** in the top left corner of the dialog window.
- 9. At this point you can do a **Quick scan** if you like, by clicking the Quick scan button.

The next category is Account protection. This will tell you what account your computer uses to sign in and manage everything about your PC in relation to your Microsoft account.

Firewall & network protection is the third category. Here you would want to make sure you have Domain network, Private network and Public network turned on.
